# RABBI'S CORNER

Shabbat Ha Hodesh is the fourth special Shabbat before the festival of Pesach. It always falls before Rosh Hodesh Nisan. A special maftir portion is read from Parashat Bo in the Book of Exodus which speaks of Nisan and the night of its first day. We read about the Pesach lamb sacrifice with unleavened bread and bitter herbs (sound familiar?) and of the painting the blood of the sacrificed lamb on the doorposts of Israelite houses, (earliest graffiti was done by Israelites!) The reading speaks of the story and various laws of Pesach connecting us to our ancient history with the purposes to inspire your Pesach preparations — two weeks away. Get ready!!
