RABBI'S CORNER

Parashat Naso lists the service each family shall undertake for the sake of the community and in honor of God. Then God tells Moses to advise the Israelites: If a man or a woman commits a transgression they must then make restitution. If there is infidelity in a relationship, the priest gets involved to determine the veracity of the accusation.

When someone resolves to take the vow of a Nazir, to elevate oneself temporarily to a position akin to that of a priest, they will not drink wine or shave their heads. However, sacrifices with the priest shall be made and offerings given to God to regain purity.

God then tells Moses to have Aaron bless Israel with "Birkat Kohanim", "May God bless you and keep you. May God illuminate the Almighty Countenance for you and favor you. May God lift up God's Countenance toward you and establish peace for you.' They shall place My Name upon the sons of Israel; and as for Me, I shall bless them."

Naso, the longest parasha of the entire Torah, ends with the subject of different contributions made by Israel to the upkeep of the Tabernacle, everyone according to his/her own capabilities.
