



The CDC recently released updated vaccine and mask guidance relative to resuming commonly enjoyed activities. As such, TBE is relaxing masking policies to align with CDC guidance with the following provisions:

- There are no mask wearing requirements for outdoor activities and/or programming.
- For indoor activities (e.g., services), mask wearing is now optional for those who are fully vaccinated. In general, people are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after their second dose in a two-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine. If you don't meet these requirements, regardless of your age, you are NOT fully vaccinated and you must wear a mask.
- Please be prepared to show proof of vaccination if asked.
- Social distancing remains in effect indoors and is encouraged outdoors. When indoors, all services will be held in the main sanctuary where there is ample, comfortable seating.
- Children under the age of 12 are encouraged to mask to the best of their ability.

We understand and appreciate that there will be varying levels of comfort in attending in-person services, programming, and activities at TBE. We similarly appreciate your patience with and respect for one another as we adjust and make accommodations while progressing towards a new normal. Our commitment to you is that we will revisit guidance and policy again as the state of public health continues to improve.

Note that services will continue to be streamed via Zoom and Facebook for those of you continuing to join remotely. As always, be in-touch if we can be of assistance.
