



Dear Congregant,

In accordance with our ongoing policy to take all precautions necessary to keep everyone as safe as possible, we have reviewed new local guidelines and CDC recommendations and we are updating COVID protocols at Temple Beth El immediately as follows:

- **Vaccinations:** We are requiring anyone 12 or older entering the building to provide proof of vaccination or a recent negative COVID test (within 48 hours). Proof of vaccination can be in the form of:
 - A vaccination card (or copy or photo of one)
 - An Excelsior pass
 - By uploading your vaccination information to <https://www.tberochester.org/pray/hhd>
- **Masks:** Everyone entering the building must wear a mask. This policy is being put into place in order to protect the greater community, particularly those not yet eligible to be vaccinated and those who are at high risk.
- **General:** If you or anyone in your household is exhibiting any symptoms, please stay home.

With these new guidelines in place, we are hopeful it will continue to be safe to welcome you to Temple Beth El for daily, weekly Shabbat and High Holy Day services and programming.
