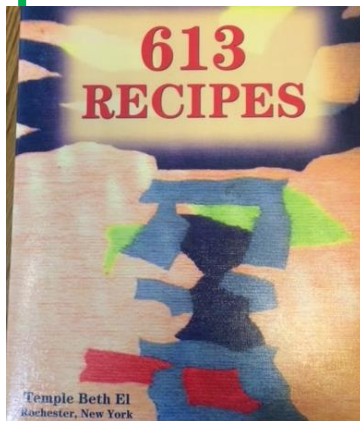

GUATEMALAN CHAROSET 🌸 (Pareve)

| 3 granny smith apples, peeled & chopped | ½ can green chilis |
| 2 Tbsp. chopped cashews | 2 tsp. chopped sweet onion |
| 2 Tbsp. honey | 2 garlic cloves, minced |
| 1 oz. Passover wine | 1 small tomato, chopped |
| 1 Tbsp. fresh chopped cilantro | 1 Tbsp. red wine vinegar |
| | 1 Tbsp. olive oil |

In a bowl mix together the apples, cashews, honey, wine and cilantro. Place the chilis, onion, garlic, tomato, wine vinegar and oil in a blender and blend into a thick liquid. Add as much of the liquid mixture to the apple mixture as is to your liking and stir well. Keep in the refrigerator for about 2 hours before serving to let the flavors blend.

Note: In place of fresh garlic you can use minced garlic in a jar.
